- Targeted interventions before and after school

 - Apex Summer School at the high school: original credit and credit recovery
- Adjusted student schedule in grades 7-12
 - Increase course offerings from 6 in the 2020-21 school year to 8 in the 2021-22 school year
 - Allows students with incompletes to earn credit and not fall behind
 - Allows students the opportunity to explore more courses and interests
