Business Operations Report - Sheila Baker gave the business operations report.

General Fund – For the month of February Expenditures were over Revenue received by \$267,020.14.

Fund Balance in all funds:

General Fund: \$535,178.

Cap Project - \$82,920

Debt Service Fund - \$303,221

ASB Fund - \$253,727.

Transportation Vehicle Fund - \$190,003.

The fund balance projection spreadsheet I send each month has been updated with the January apportionment figures updated to reflect amounts based on actual enrollment. The projection for our ending fund balance is approximately \$1.4 million.

Our fund balance continues to decline as is common with other districts across the state. The challenges of increased salary and benefit costs based on the IPD increase of 5.5% for this school year has contributed to this decline. We pass this amount on to all staff although OSPI increases the funded base salary by this amount. We are also experiencing an increase in substitute costs both with certificated and classified staff as absences have increased this school year.

As we begin to work on the 23-24 budget we will be looking at current positions that are funded with ESSER dollars. These dollars will be almost completely expended by the end of this current fiscal year.

As we look at the enrollment forecast for 23-24 school year, the question is always how many



kindergarten students will we have. Also, decisions that the legislature will make could have an impact on transitional kindergarten.

Enrollment: Our February FTE was 1,405.22 which is a decrease of 3.63 FTE from January. Our Annual Average Enrollment is 1,407.73 remaining 46.73 FTE higher than budgeted.
