

Declaration of Intent to Provide Home-Based Instruction

RCW 28A.200.010 · Format prescribed by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (Form A-2) · One form per family, filed each school year

I declare that I am the parent, guardian, or legal custodian of the child or children listed below; that each child is between the ages of 8 and 18 and is therefore subject to chapter 28A.225 RCW (Compulsory Attendance); and that I intend to cause each child to receive home-based instruction as described in RCW 28A.225.010(4). What happens next. We confirm we received your declaration. That is all. Keep a copy with your child's records. There is no fee, and the district cannot ask for anything beyond this form (RCW 28A.200.020). This declaration must be filed annually with the superintendent of the district in which the parent resides, or with a nonresident district that has accepted the student as a transfer (RCW 28A.225.220). Under 8 years old: no declaration is required. Home-schooled students remain entitled to part-time enrollment and ancillary services in their resident district (RCW 28A.150.350; Board Policy 3114).
